EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT

Program Objectives

The Certificate of Advanced Studies in Educational Leadership and Management Program prepares the candidate to meet the new Massachusetts Professional Standards and Indicators for Administrative Leadership as either a Supervisor/Director (P-12) or School Principal (P-6, 5-8, 9-12). The program offers courses and field experiences that equip school administrators with the skills and competencies necessary for becoming effective educational leaders.

About the Program

The CAGS Program is an interdepartmental program. Within this spirit, relationships between faculty members in education departments and other programs across the college have been allied.

Program Description

The CAGS program in Educational Leadership and Management is designed for candidates with the desire to:

- Develop competencies in managerial skills related to political arenas, personnel, fiscal affairs, acquisition of material resources, diverse publics and pupil populations and organizational change
- Strengthen, deepen and expand the knowledge base in the field of leadership and management in order to anticipate and to solve current and future problems inherent in the educational system
- Demonstrate through course work and field-based experiences the knowledge, skills and attitudes that are required to lead and manage an educational enterprise effectively and efficiently

The Program offers preparation for two Massachusetts Educator Licenses

Principal Licensure (PreK-6, 5-8, 9-12) — 42 graduate credits Supervisor/Director Licensure (P-12) — 39 graduate credits

There are two initial licensure options in this program.

There is one option for students who wish to seek school principal licensure and a second option for candidates who wish to supervise or direct programs in a school system.

Successful completion of the degree and all requisite licensure requirements qualifies degree recipients for endorsement as a principal or supervisor/director.

Program Requirements

A minimum of 39-42 graduate credits is required to complete the CAGS program as well as to prepare for application for one of the two initial licenses: principal license (Option A) and supervisor/director (Option B). Both programs consist of:

- A core of tightly-focused and comprehensive courses
- Field Work that encompasses pre-practicum and practicum experiences. These experiences are designed to develop the knowledge, skills, and dispositions of effective administrators, ready and able to positively lead schools and improve student learning.
- Pre-practicum experiences are integrated into course content. Candidates have opportunities to apply course content in a practical way in the field.
- The program of study includes 2 practicum courses
 (100 practicum hours for each). Occurring near the end
 of the program and before the practicum, these courses
 deepen candidate knowledge and skills in discrete areas
 of the effective administrator (collegial supervision
 and planned change)
- The practicum consists of 300 hours (principal) or 100 hours (supervisor/director). Candidates apply the knowledge and skills acquired in course work under the guidance of a supervising administrator and university supervisor.
